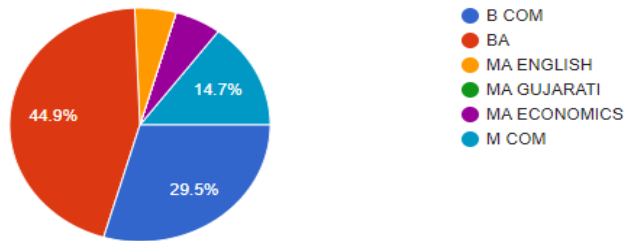

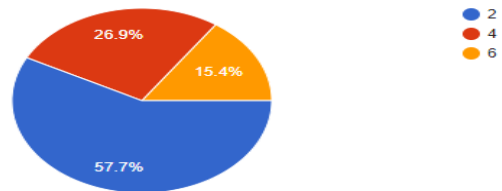

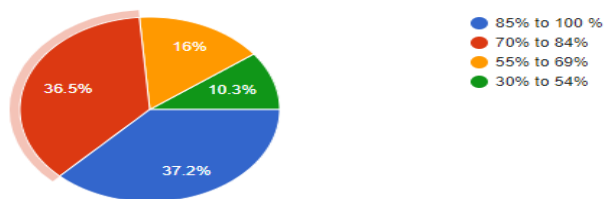

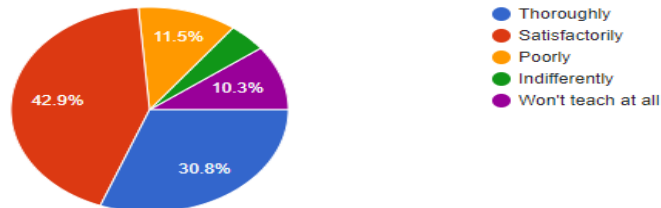

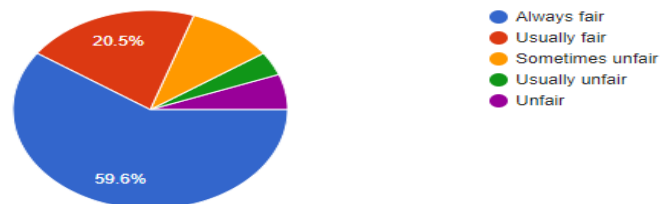

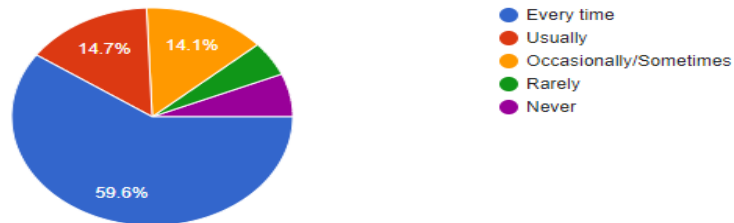

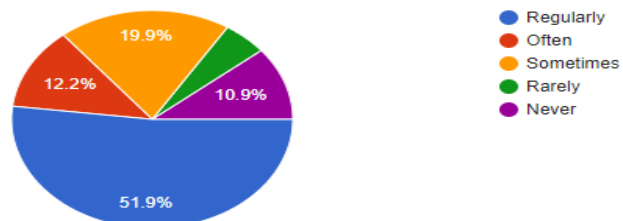

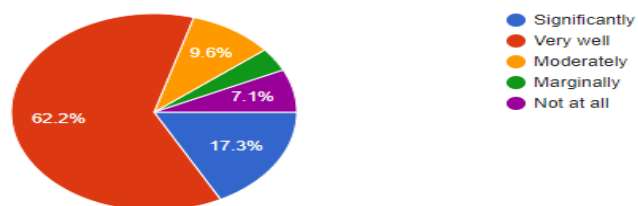

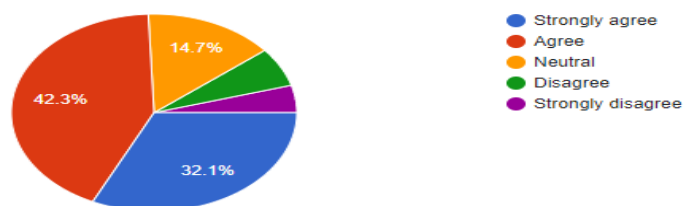

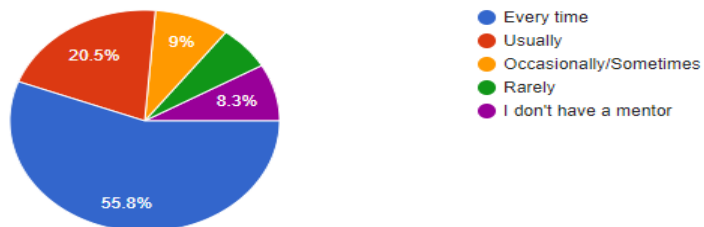

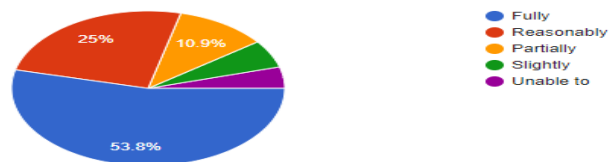

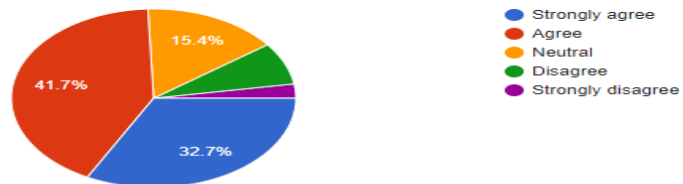

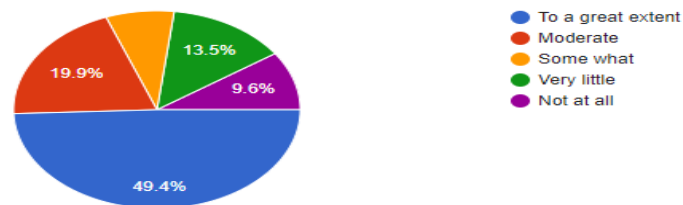

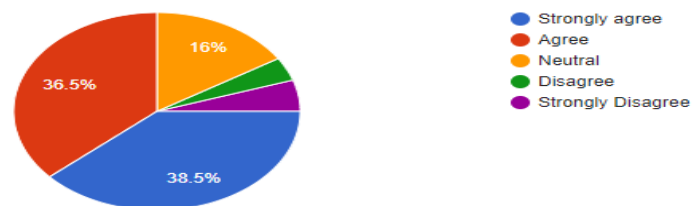

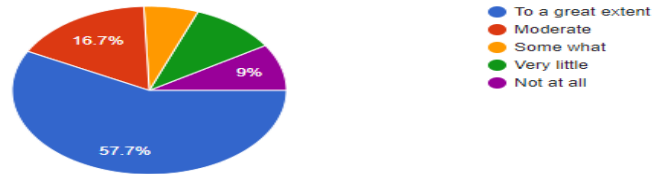

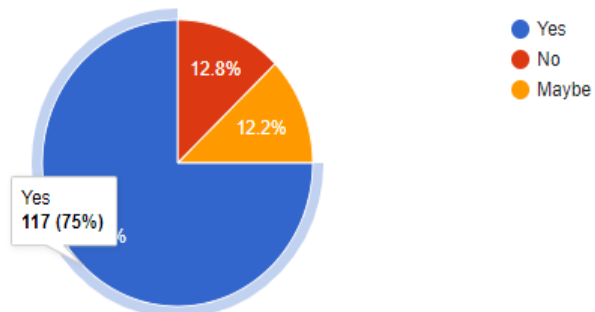

Analysis of Student's Satisfaction Survey :

The survey was conducted by the college IQAC using google form. The analysis of the data obtained clearly shows that students are satisfied with the college's curricular and co-curricular activities. Students are also quite satisfied with teaching in the classroom and teaching methodology used by faculties. Teachers organize continuous evaluation through assignments, poster presentation, power point presentation and it has good impact.

The college provides platform for the students to grow through practical training which is done through workshops, webinars and project work. They are given encouragement by the faculties and they are also sent to different colleges of university for various academic competitions. Teachers act as their mentors. Students are guided and their progress is monitored time to time.

The college provides platform to students who are interested in sports, fine arts and other co-curricular and extra curricular activities. The college organizes Christmas Carnival and Spring Fest which includes various activities like Rangoli, Poster Making, cooking, photography, Dance, singing, Elocution, Debate, Essay writing, Poetry recitation, Food stalls, sports events like track and field events. During the year some events were organized virtually due to COVID-19. Students are also encouraged to participate in university youth festival and winners and participants are rewarded with trophy and certificates respectively.

The data clearly shows that even during lockdown and partial lockdown when classes were in Online mode, the college regularly conducted online classes and 75% of the students are happy with the online classes. Faculties tried their best to put the best foot forward in this new way of teaching and learning.
